Winning time for each division is set by a member of the Bedford County Hunt. For 100 Club, the sum of 2 riders' ages must be equal or greater than 100. A team may consist of any number of riders. Two ribbons will be awarded to the first 4 places in each division.

From Lynchburg/Forest: Rt. 221 South towards Bedford. Turn right on Brookhill Road. Then take first right on Cifax Road. Drive 3.2 miles and parking is on right in a hay field.

From Bedford: Rt. 221 North towards Lynchburg. Turn left on Goode Station Road. Turn left on Cifax Road. Drive 2.2 miles and parking is on right in a hay field.

From Big Island: Rt. 122 South towards Bedford. Turn left on Otterville Road. Continue to Cifax intersection (the only stop sign). Turn left and then an immediate right on Cifax Road. Parking is on left in a hay field.
