First pace team out 9:00 a.m. — Last pace team out 11:00 a.m.

Four Pace Divisions: Full Cry - Hilltopper - Trail Ride – Junior

Winning time for each division is set by a member of the Bedford County Hunt. Junior teams must include one rider under the age of 18 and are measured against the Hilltopper time. A team may consist of any number of riders. Two ribbons will be awarded to the first 4 places in each division.

Directions to Maceland Farm (421 Craddock Lane, Chatham, VA 24531):

From the North: Follow Rt 29 South. About 6 miles past Rt40/Gretna-Rocky Mount exit (will pass two churches, one called Oak Grove) turn right on Rt 801 and immediately take a hard right on to Rt 803 (Hawkins Rd). Travel 0.8 mile and turn right on to Craddock Lane. Follow to parking in field on right.

From the South: Follow Rt 29 North. Approximately 5 miles past the first Chatham exit (just beyond Tightsqueeze), watch for the Old Dominion Agriculture Complex on the southbound side of Rt 29. Turn left on Rt 801 and immediately take a hard right on to Rt 803 (Hawkins Rd). Travel 0.8 mile and turn right on to Craddock Lane. Follow to parking in field on right.

From the West: From Rt 57 East (Martinsville) turn left on to Rt 793 (Cherrystone Lake Rd). Travel approx. 1 mile and turn right on Rt 802 (Hodnetts Mill Rd). Take first left on to Rt 803 (Hawkins Rd). Travel approx. 1.5 miles and turn left on to Craddock Lane. Follow to parking in field on right.
