### **Directions:**

**From Lynchburg:** Take Business US-29 North through Madison Heights. Turn left at the CITGO station onto Smokey Hollow Rd (Rt 663). Continue about 1 mile, road turns to gravel, continue another 0.3 mile and turn right into the Harriet Rogers Riding Center. Follow signs for parking.

**From Roanoke:** Take US-460 East to US-29 North. Take the Amherst/Sweet Briar College exit. Turn left at end of exit ramp onto Business US-29 South. Go past entrance to main campus and travel about 2 miles and turn right at the CITGO station onto Smokey Hollow Rd (Rt 663). Continue about 1 mile, road turns to gravel, continue another 0.3 mile and turn right into the Harriet Rogers Riding Center. Follow signs for parking.

**From point north:** Take US-29 South. Take Sweet Briar College exit and merge onto Business US-29 South. Go past entrance to main campus and travel about 2 miles and turn right at the CITGO station onto Smokey Hollow Rd (Rt 663). Continue about 1 mile, road turns to gravel, continue another 0.3 mile and turn right into the Harriet Rogers Riding Center. Follow signs for parking.
