Directions:

From Lynchburg: Take HWY Business 29 North through Madison Heights. Turn left past the CITGO stations onto Smokey Hollow Rd (Rt 663) continue 1 mile, bear right at the fork and continue 0.3 mi to the Harriet Rogers Riding Center. Follow signs for parking.

From Amherst: Take HWY 29 South to Madison Heights/Sweetbriar exit. Stay left on exit ramp. At stop sign, turn left onto Business 29 South. Go 2 miles and turn right before the CITGO onto Smokey Hollow Rd (Rt 663) continue 1 mile, bear right at the fork and continue 0.3 mi to the Harriet Rogers Riding Center. Follow signs for parking.
