From **Amherst**: HWY 29 South to Madison Heights/Sweetbriar exit. Go 2 mi and turn right before the CITGO onto Smokey Hollow Rd (Rt 663) continue 1 mi, bear right at the fork and continue 0.3 mi to the Harriet Rogers Riding Center. Follow signs for parking.
