Each pace has four divisions: Full Cry - Hilltopper - Trail Ride – Juniors

Winning time for each division is set by a member of the Bedford County Hunt and 2 ribbons will be awarded to the first 4 places in each division. For the Juniors Division, one member of the team must be 17 years old or younger.

The BCH **Jesse Ray Ford Perpetual Trophy** will be awarded to the team (or individual) that earns the highest total number of points in the 2020 Hunter Pace Series. The winner must compete in all paces and in the same division in all paces.

The BCH **William R. King Perpetual Trophy** will be awarded to the junior team (or individual) that earns the highest total number of points in the 2020 Hunter Pace Series. The winner must compete in the Junior Division in all paces.

The June pace also offers two optional trail classes: In-Hand Trail and Trail Obstacle that are part of the Shenandoah Valley Judged Trail Ride Series jointly sponsored with Rockbridge and Glenmore Hunts.

Ribbons will be awarded to the first 6 places in each class.
